

Reverend Bobby Smallwood was born in Pitt County, North Carolina. He accepted the Lord in his life at an early age under the anointed preaching of his brother Rev. Richard Smallwood, who conducted services in the family home. Reverend Smallwood was baptized at the Indian Woods Baptist Church in Windsor, NC.

Reverend Smallwood enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1978. Upon receiving an honorable discharge from the U.S. Army in 1985, he settled in Woodbridge, Virginia where he met his wife Jan Ligon Smallwood. They have been married for 32 years and from this union they have been blessed with two wonderful children, a daughter-in law, and one grandson.

Reverend Smallwood re-dedicated his life to Christ in 1991 and became a member of the Neabsco Baptist Church in Woodbridge VA where he participated in the Prison Ministry and served in the music ministry. He also taught Sunday school and Vacation Bible School classes.

Reverend Smallwood was ordained as a Deacon at the Neabsco Baptist Church in 1997 and served until accepting his calling into the ministry in December 1999. He preached his initial sermon and was licensed to preach the Gospel in March 2000 under the pastoral leadership of Reverend Dr. Ambrose M. Perry. He was ordained on March 12, 2006 at the Little Forest Baptist Church under the pastoral leadership of Reverend Nelson Sneed where he served as an Associate Minister and Director of the Outreach Ministry. Reverend Smallwood was installed as Pastor of the Shiloh Old Site Baptist Church on May 2, 2009 where he served until 2017.

In 2017, Pastor Smallwood stepped out on faith and planted the Bible Way Christian Church in Stafford, Virginia and preaches and teaches passionately each week from the Word of God. His God-given vision for the ministry is to see Christians grounded in the Word of God, maturing in their faith, and living victoriously in Christ.

Pastor Smallwood's favorite scripture is Matthew 5:16, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven and his favorite hymn is "Jesus Keep Me Near the Cross."
