<u>Biblical Fruit of the Spirit:</u> Those things that come about as a result of the indwelling or presence of the Holy Spirit in a believer. There are nine attributes that are inspired by the Holy Spirit in Christians who are true believers of God and have faith in Him. These attributes or qualities are Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

As confirmed by the Word of God many people who fail to enjoy a spiritual life of joy, and happiness is because of themselves, no one else is to blame, just themselves. In most cases it is primary due to mental reasons rather than physical reasons that keep us from manifesting the fruits of the spirit. This type of life can be the result of holding on to past failures and disappointments that do not allow us to move forward in life, but rather keep us stagnant. God tells us in His word that in this life we will have trouble, but do not allow the trouble of this life to hold us back, because He has already overcome the world. God is telling those that believe in Him that this world may not be kind to you, because this world is in opposition to the type of life, He has called His followers to live. As a result, those who trust God and choose to follow Him will have trouble in this world, some of the infliction that will come upon you will come by the world, and others will be of your own doing. God tells us to not allow this world and the things o this world to rob us of our joy and happiness, because He has already defected the world, and therefore as his followers we are more victorious through Him

- John 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace.
 In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.
- Romans 8:36-37 As it is written, FOR THY SAKE WE ARE KILLED ALL THE DAY LONG; WE ARE ACCOUNTED AS SHEEP FOR THE SLAUGHTER. (37) Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.
